Directions

From Milwaukee:

Take I94 to the Hwy N exit (Cottage Grove). Turn Left and go under the interstate. Go about 2 miles. Turn right at the first stop sign, Hwy BB. Go about 1½ miles and turn left on Vilas Road (there will be a sign on the left side of the road shortly before you turn left). Go about ½ mile. Door Creek Golf Course is on the right side of Vilas Road.

From the Madison area:

Take the Beltline, Hwy 12-18 to Hwy 51, Stoughton Road. Exit and Take Hwy 51 North. Take the Cottage Grove Road exit. Turn left at the stop sign at the bottom of the ramp. Travel approximately 5 miles down Cottage Grove Road (going east). Turn right on Vilas Road (you will pass Vilas Hope Road - do not be confused by the similar names). Door Creek Golf Course is on the right.

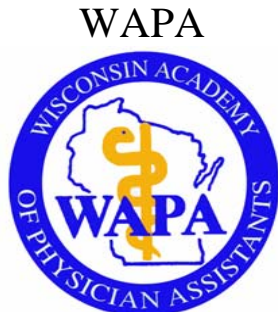
Cancellations must be made in writing and received by August 11. An administrative fee of \$25 will be assessed. No refunds will be made after August 11.
